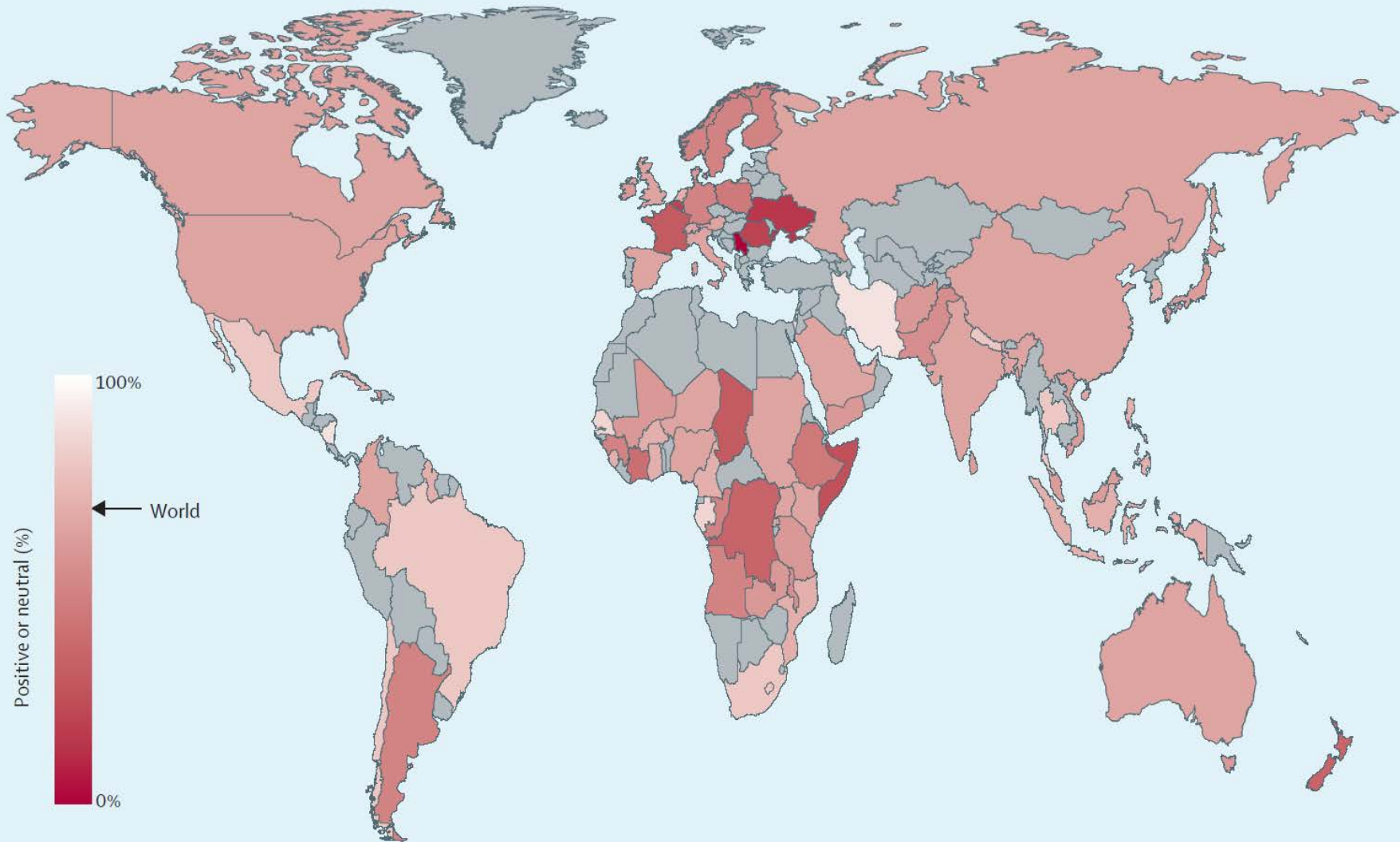

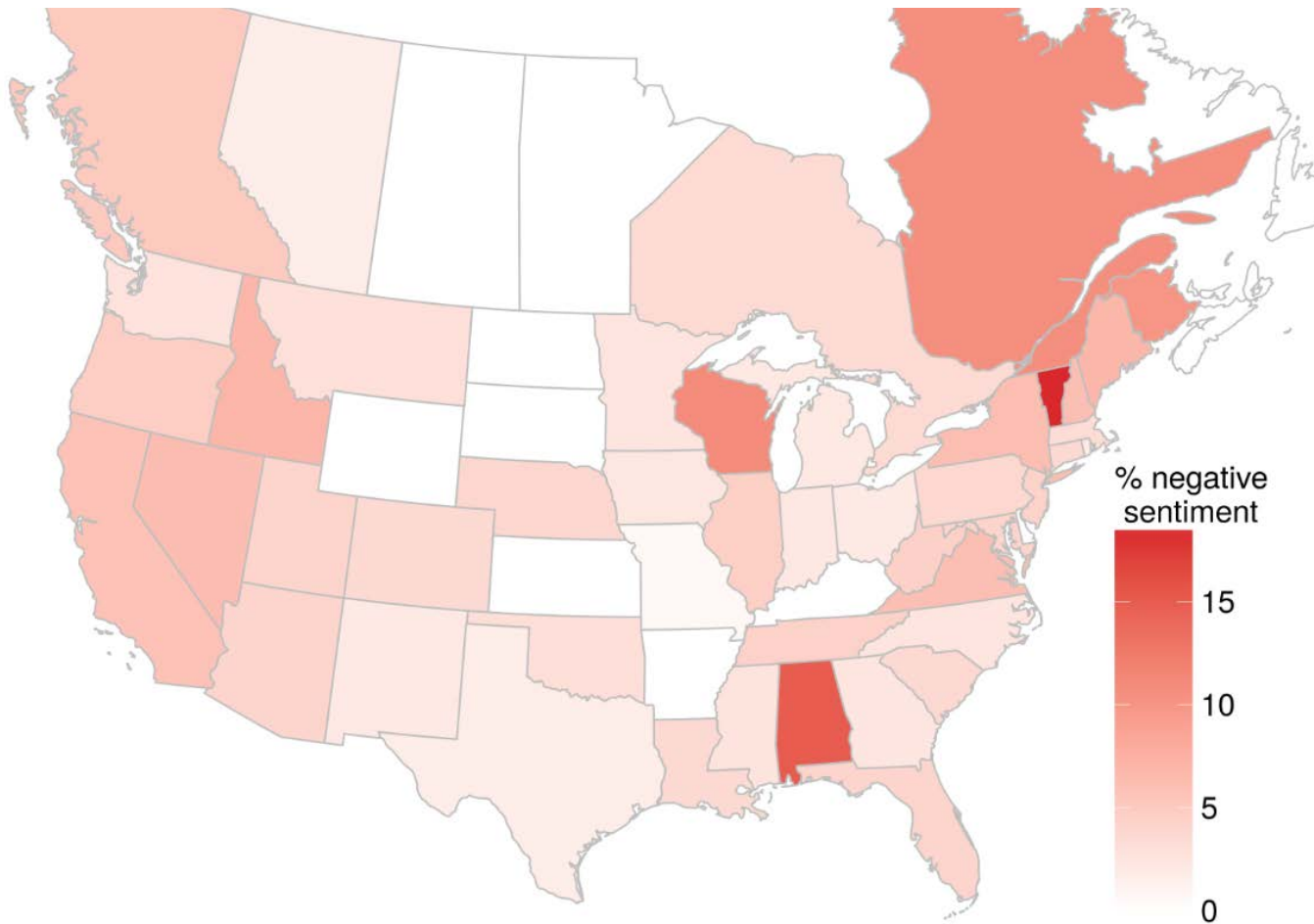

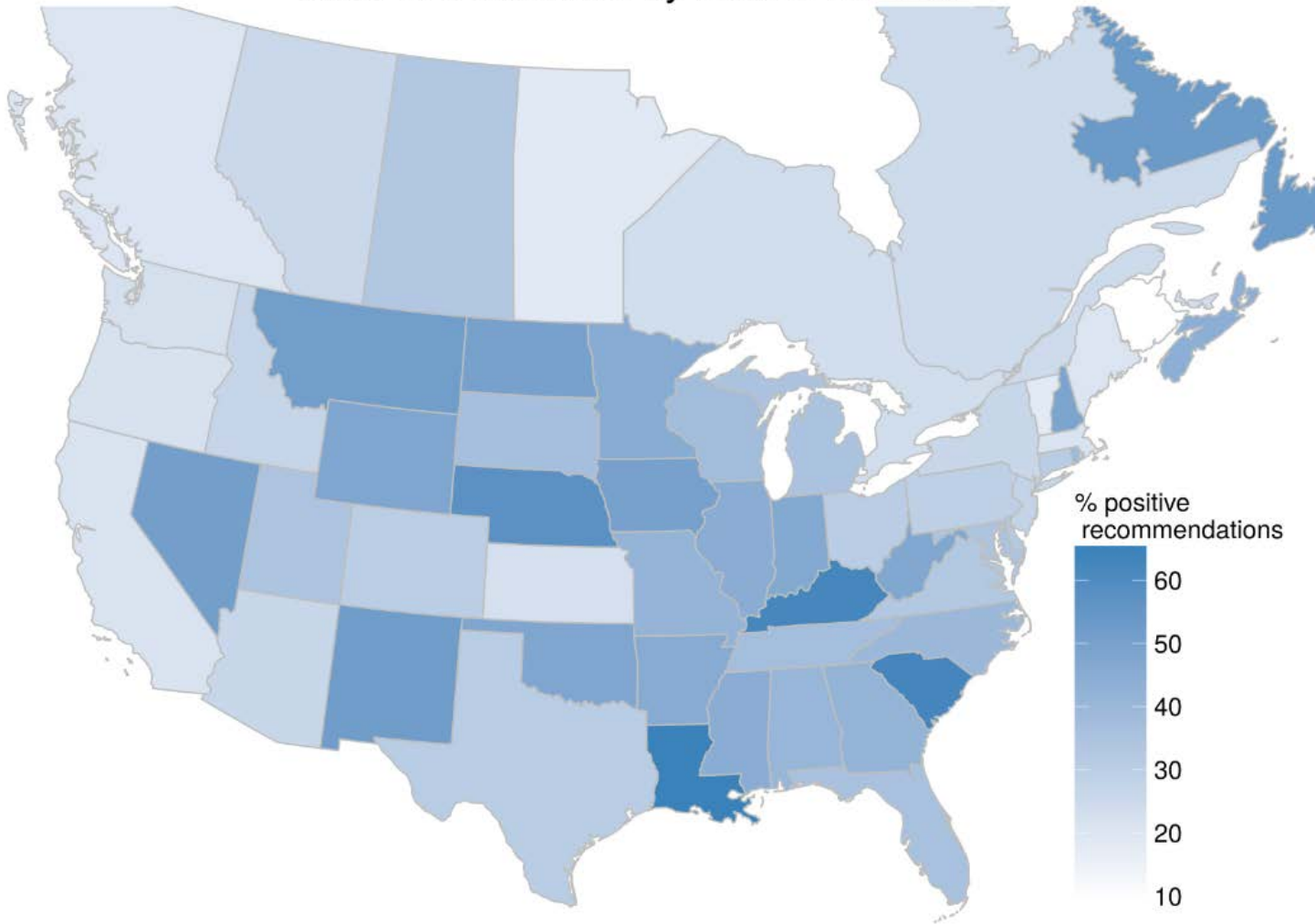

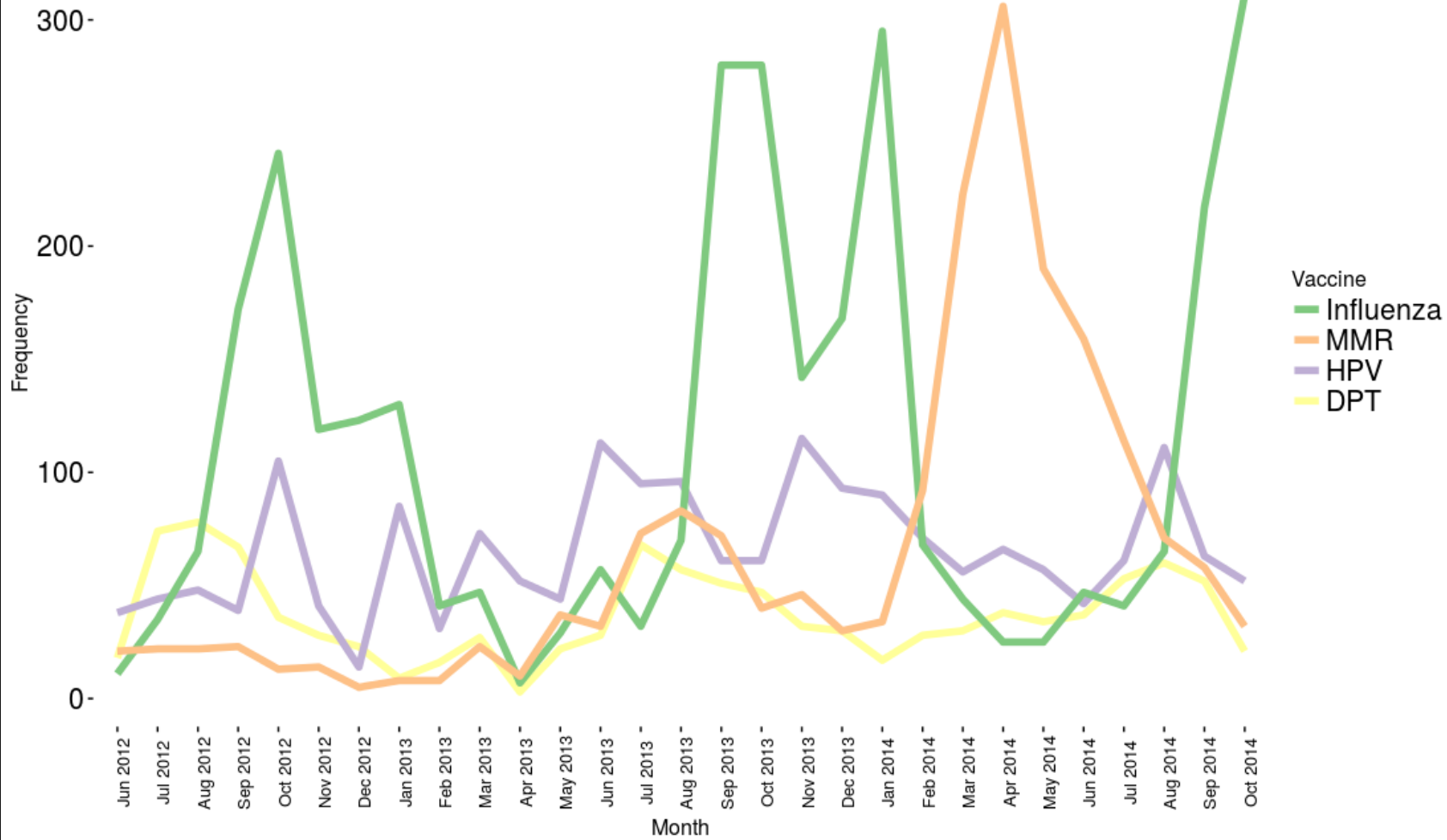

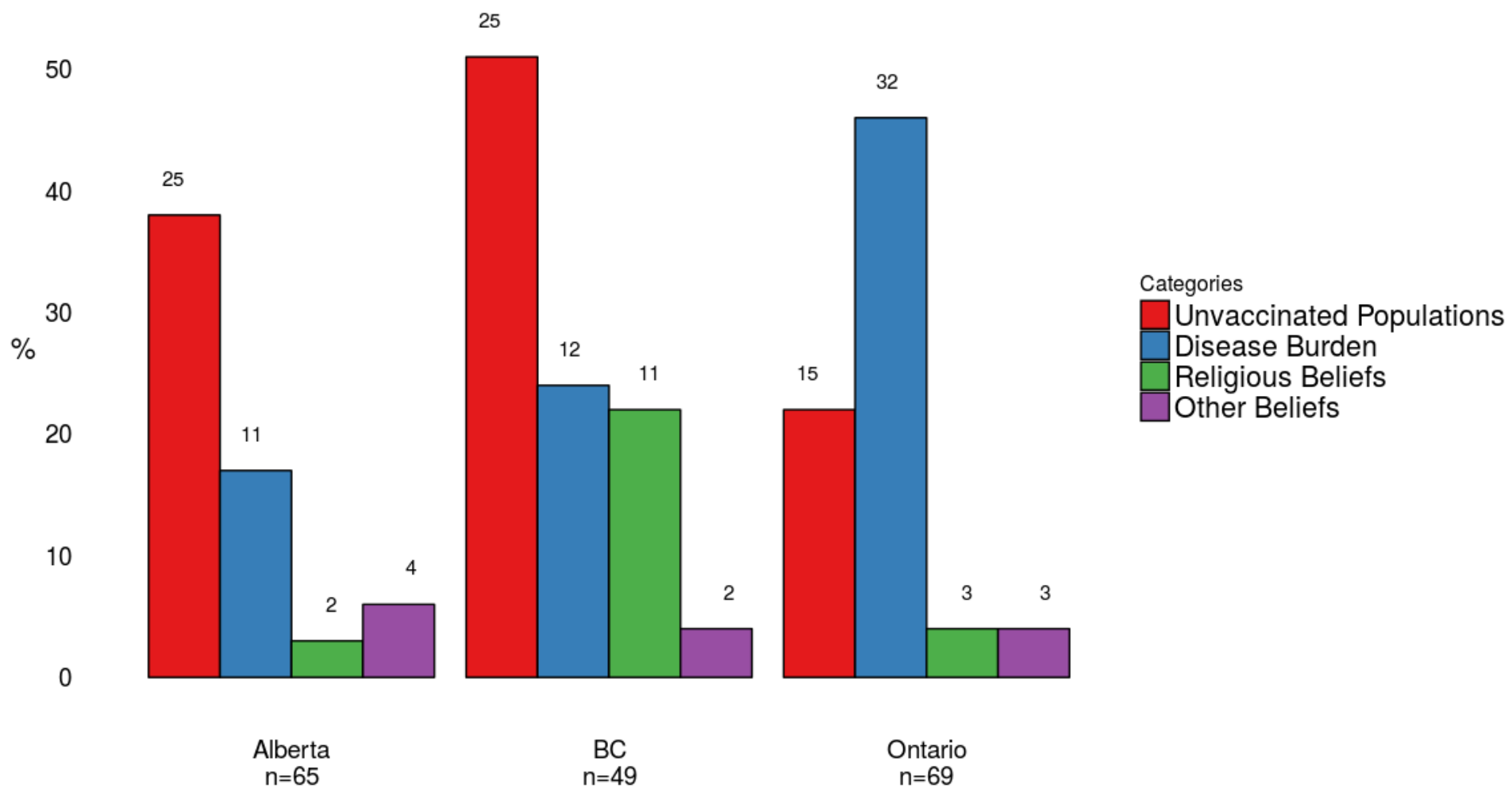
Vaccine Promotion by State/Province

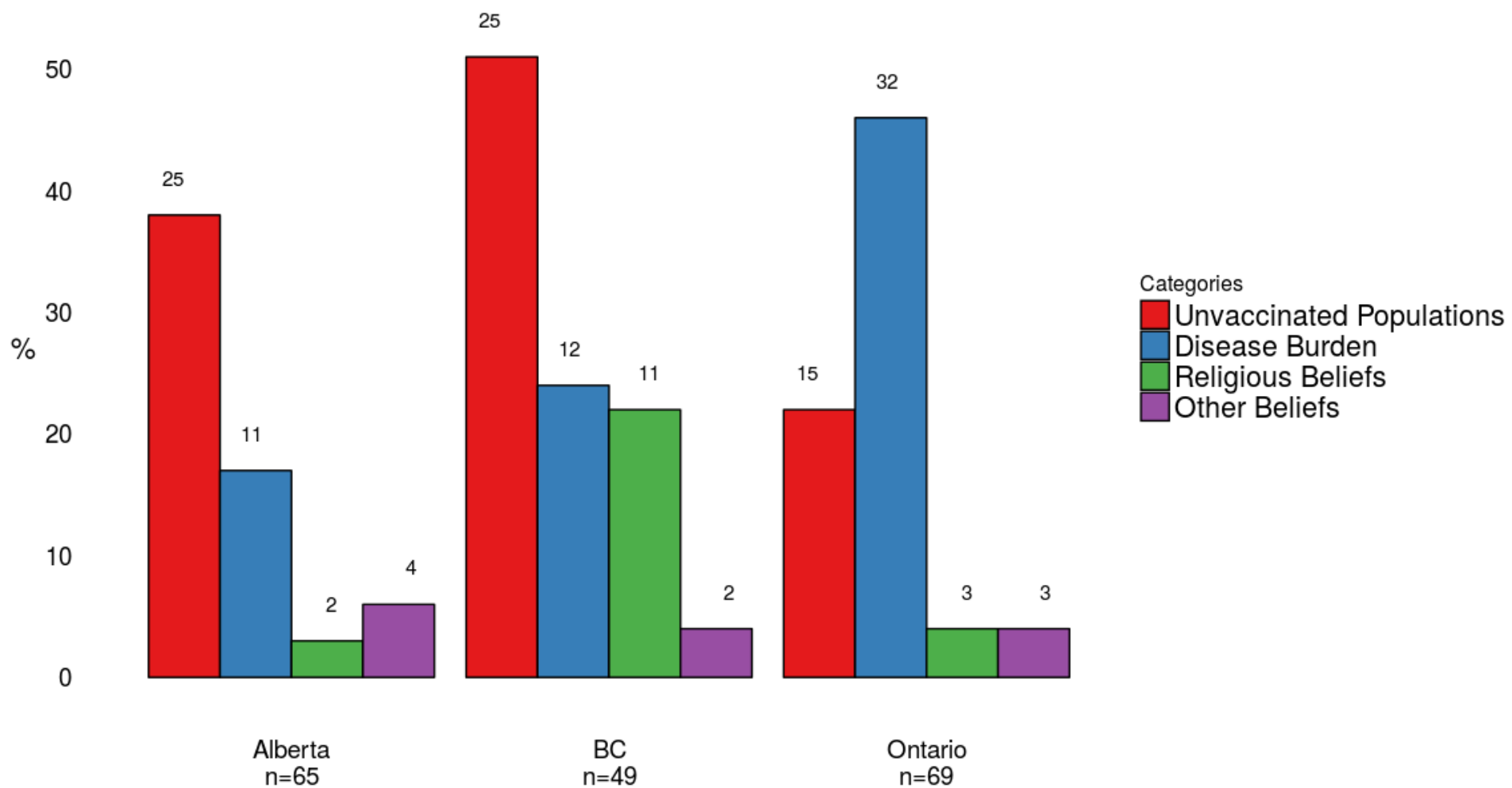
“ Most people have had a measles vaccination or for those born before 1970 are assumed to have immunity. But anyone who hasn't had two does of the measles vaccine could be at risk. ”

“ They say people should ensure they are up to date with their measles vaccine, especially if they are travelling to places where the virus is circulating. ”

British Columbia

“ Parents who resist vaccinating their children could be partly to blame for an outbreak of measles in Metro Vancouver, according to local health authorities. ”

“ The outbreak was first reported on March 8, nearly 100 kilometres away at the Mount Cheam Christian School in Chilliwack, a community with traditionally low immunization rates due to religious beliefs. ”
