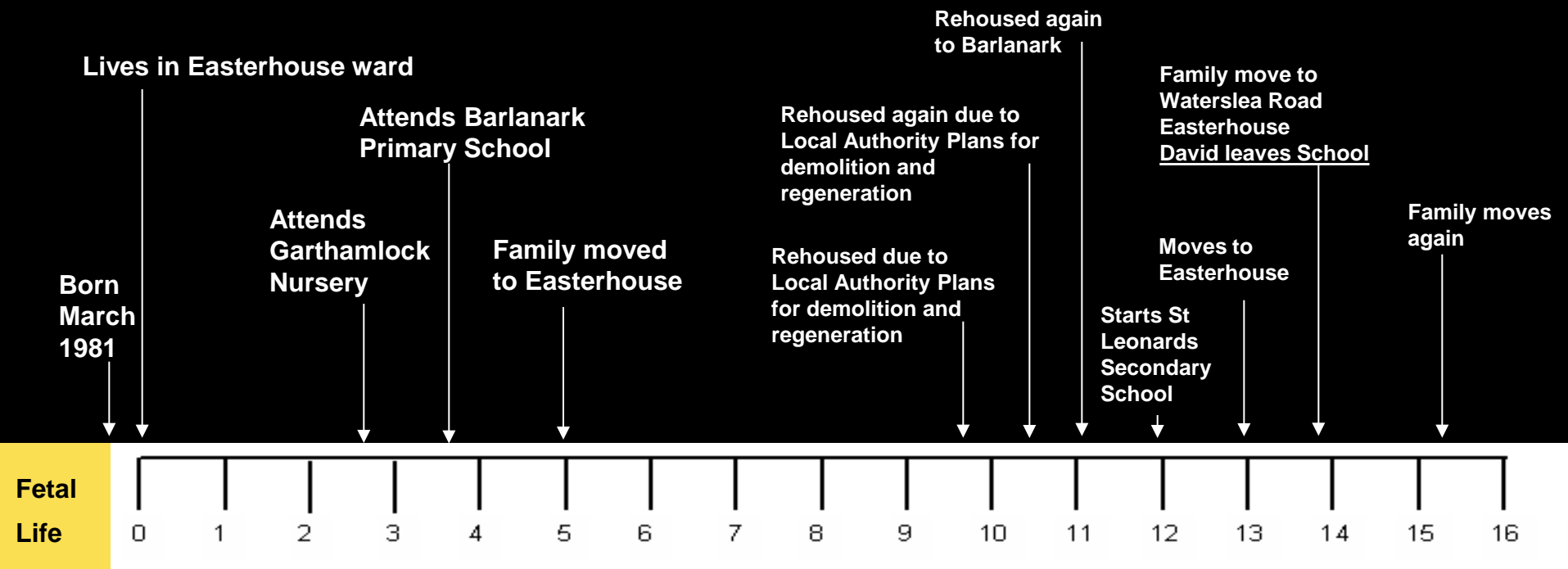
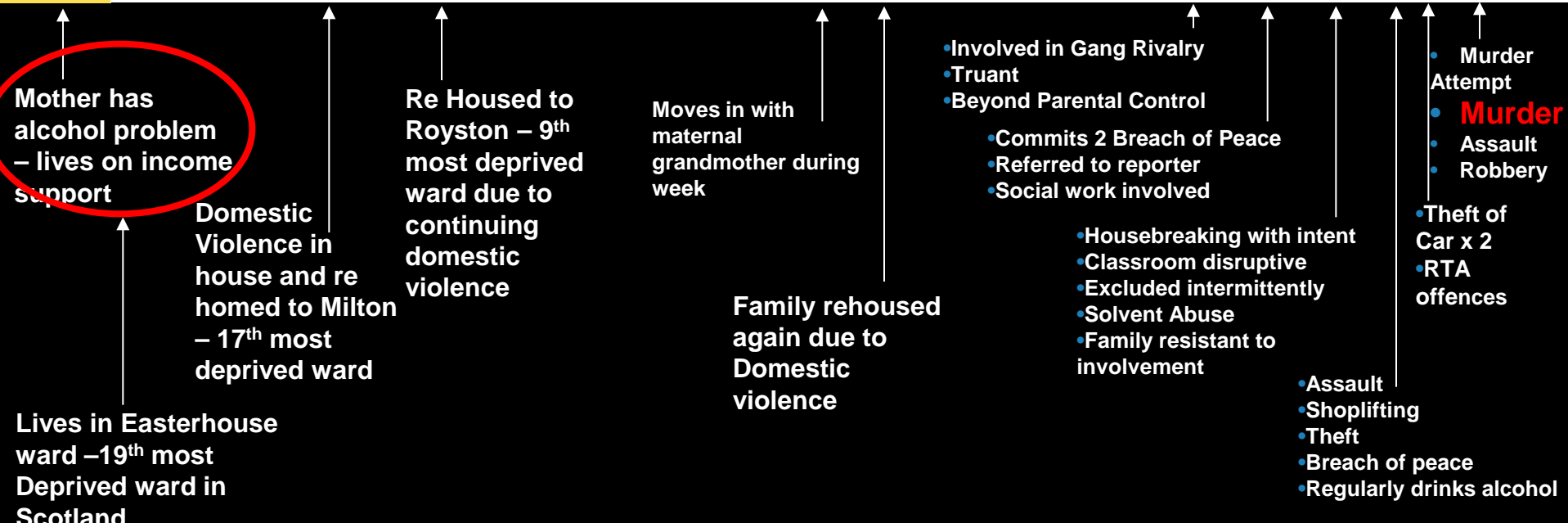
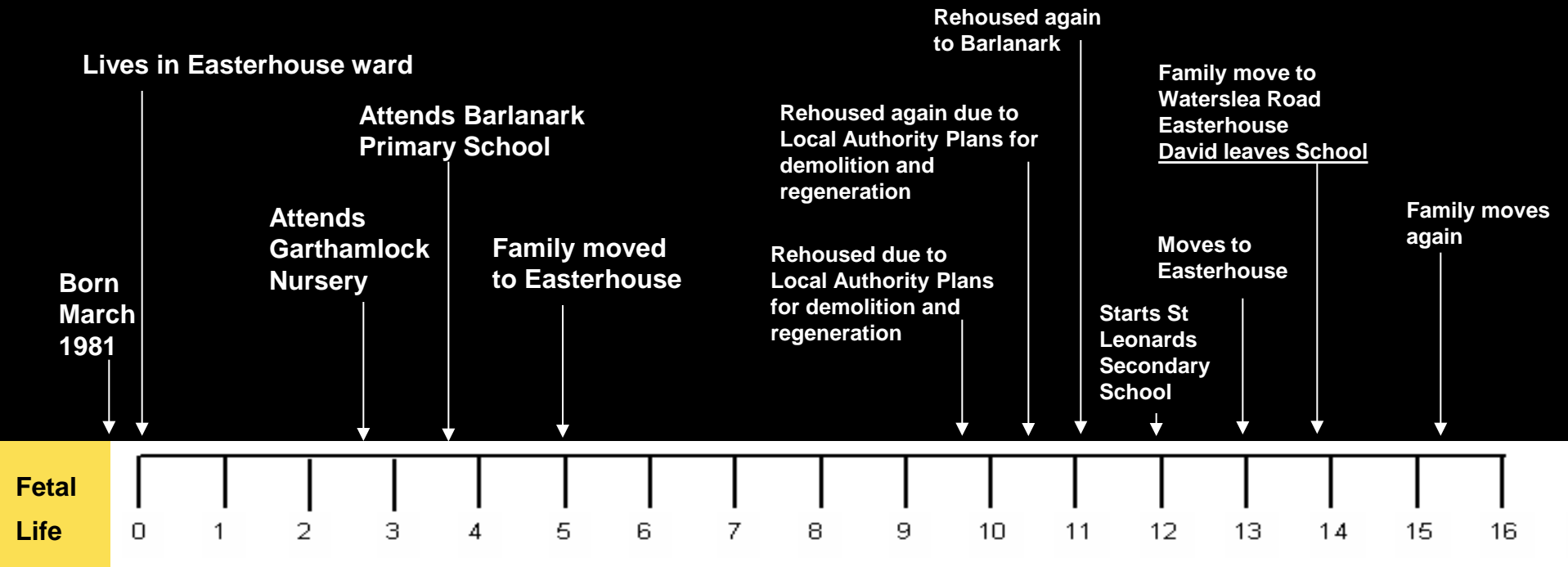

Re Housed to Royston – 9th most deprived ward due to continuing domestic violence

Moves in with maternal grandmother during week

Family rehoused again due to Domestic violence

- Involved in Gang Rivalry
- Truant
- Beyond Parental Control

- Commits 2 Breach of Peace
- Referred to reporter
- Social work involved

- Theft

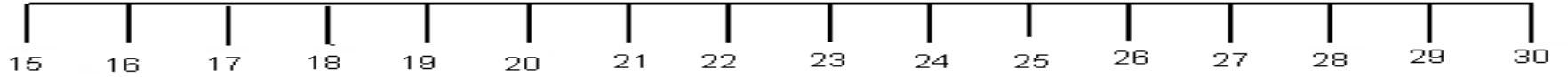

year

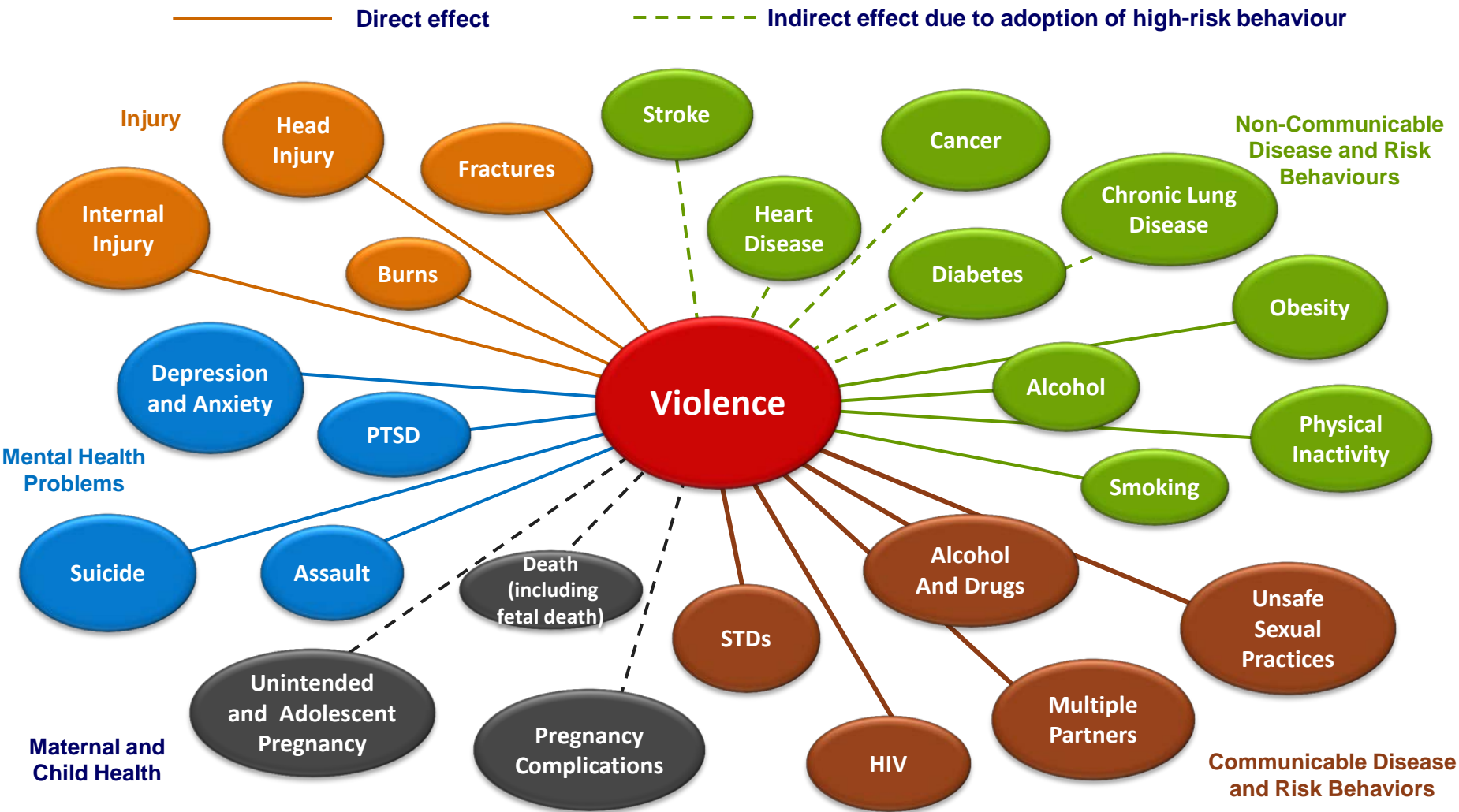
1 in 4 children

Violence prevention: what works?

1. Developing safe, stable and nurturing relationships between children and parents/caregivers
2. Developing life skills in children and adolescents
3. Reducing the availability and harmful use of alcohol
4. Reducing access to guns, knives and pesticides
5. Promoting gender equality to prevent violence against women
6. Changing cultural and social norms that support violence
7. Victim identification, care and support programmes
